
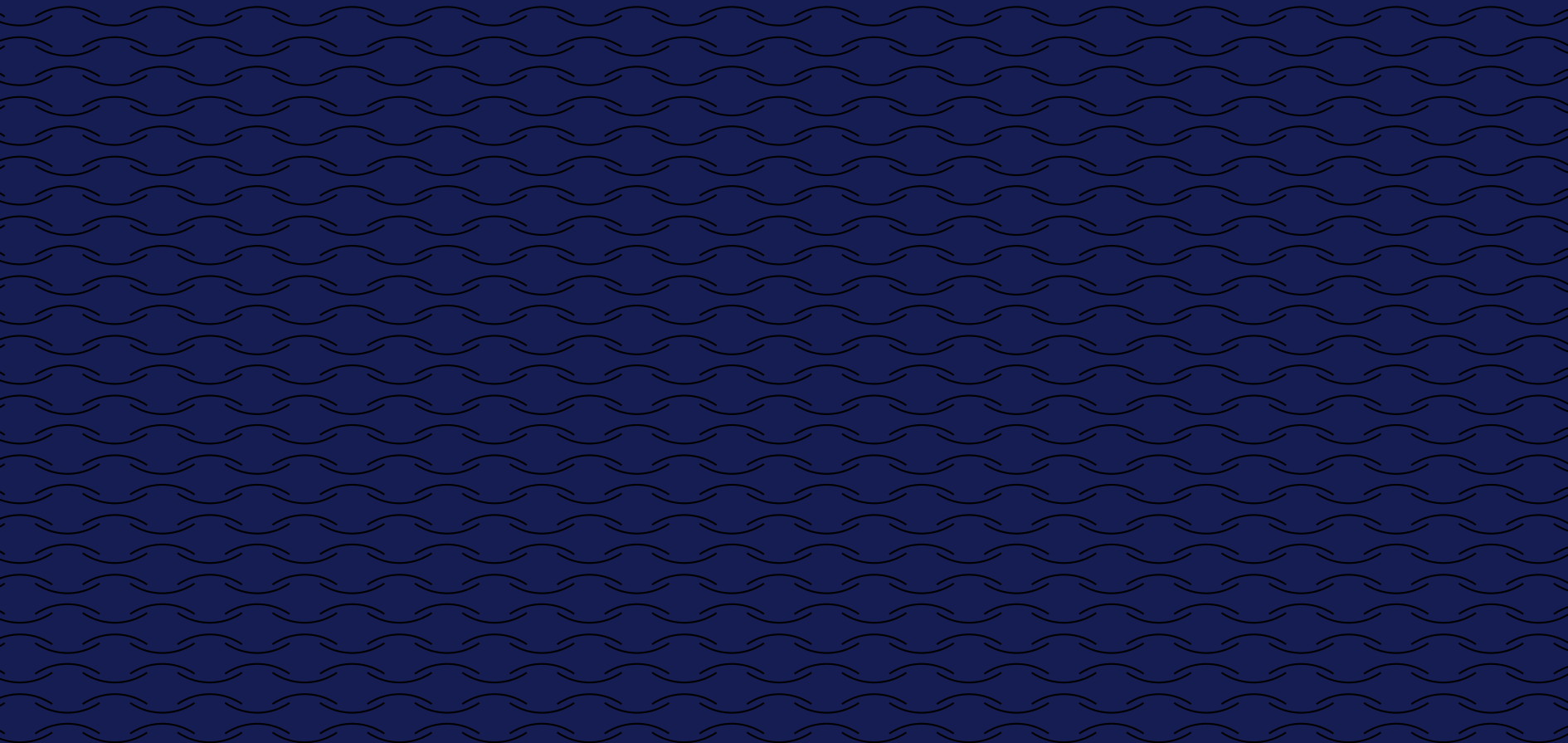


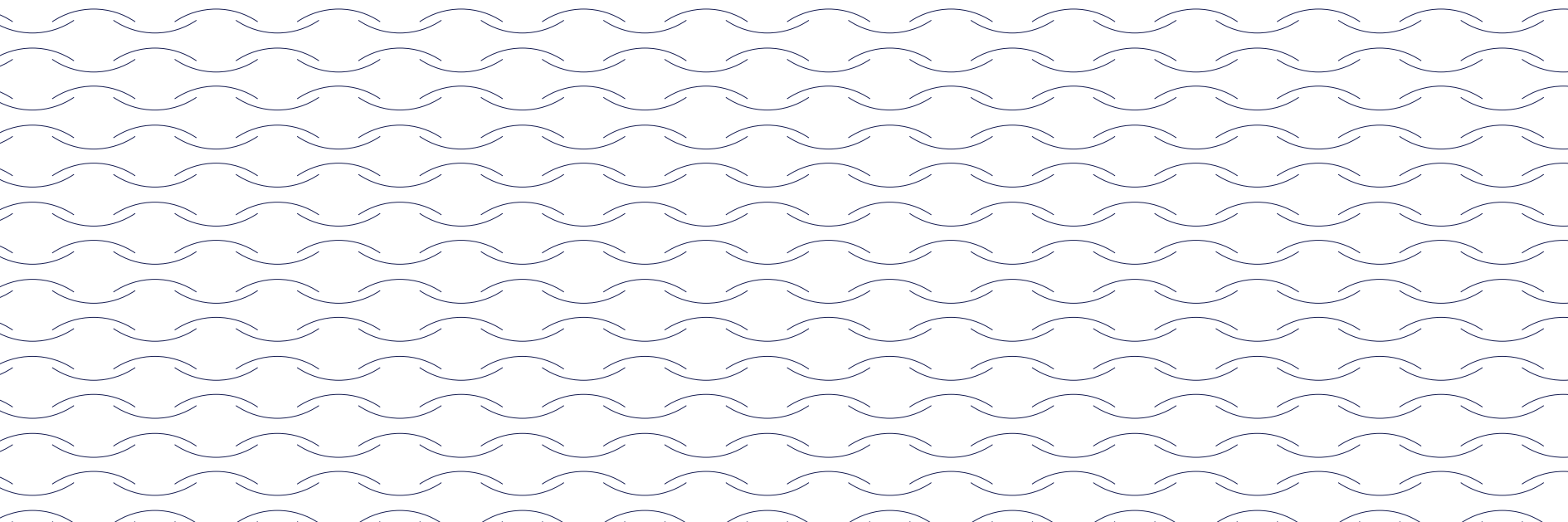

Under Alshaali's guidance, Gulf Craft has grown from being a manufacturer of small pleasure craft in 1982, to a yacht manufacturer in 1991 and a globally respected builder of superyachts since 2000.

Gulf Craft is a major manufacturer of luxury yachts and fiberglass boats and one of the world's top 10 superyacht builders (as listed in the 2014 Global Order Book). Gulf Craft, an award-winning shipyard, has built a distinguished reputation as a manufacturer of a wide diversity of vessels, ranging from fishing and family boats of 27 feet to sport cruises and semi-customized luxury superyachts of up to 155 feet.

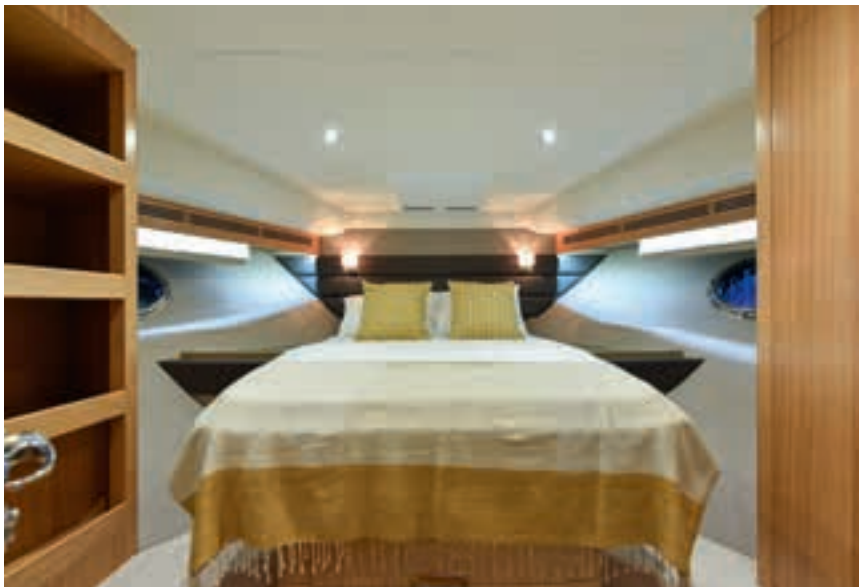

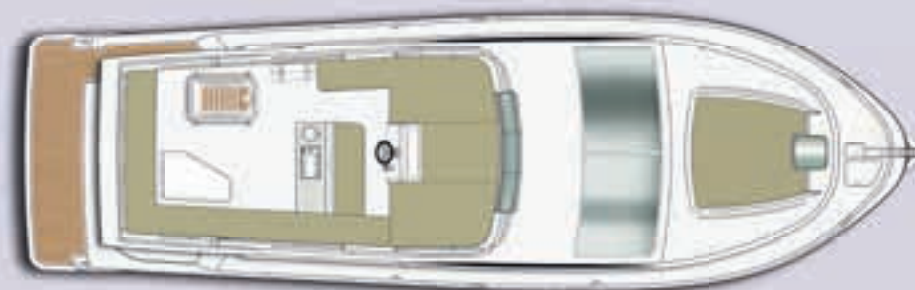
