



In 1982 Mohammed Hussein Alshaali along with his brothers Abdullah and Jamal, and Dr. Mohammed Hamdan, their long-standing friend, established Gulf Craft in the United Arab Emirates – driven by an entrepreneurial spirit, a love for the sea and a firm belief that the long-term success of the nation lay in the manufacturing industry.

Under Alshaali's guidance, Gulf Craft has grown from being a manufacturer of small pleasure craft in 1982, to a yacht manufacturer in 1991 and a globally respected builder of superyachts since 2000.

Gulf Craft is a major manufacturer of luxury yachts and fiberglass boats and one of the world's top 10 superyacht builders (as listed in the 2014 Global Order Book). Gulf Craft, an award-winning shipyard, has built a distinguished reputation as a manufacturer of a wide diversity of vessels, ranging from fishing and family boats of 27 feet to sport cruises and semi-customized luxury superyachts of up to 155 feet.

With an annual production capacity of around 400 craft and expertise built over three decades in the business, Gulf Craft has a presence in all boating markets globally through its Majesty Yachts, Oryx and Silvercraft brands. In addition, Gulf Craft provides worldwide maintenance and re-fit services as well as advisory on all aspects of boat ownership.




